

# FEZ FACTS

## THE SHRINE EMBLEM

The Crescent was adopted as the Jewel of the Order. Though any materials can be used in forming the Crescent, the most valuable are the claws of a Royal Bengal Tiger, united at their base in a gold setting. In the center is the head of a sphinx, and on the back are a pyramid, an urn and a star. The Jewel bears the motto "Robur et Furor," which means "Strength and Fury." Today, the emblem includes a scimitar from which the crescent hangs, and a five-pointed star beneath the head of the sphinx.

### NEW MEMBERSHIP APP

For dues year 2023, to acknowledge the receipt of the dues (membership) payment, Nobles will receive one communication, a 6x9 personalized postcard. The post card informs Nobles of the following:

- How to download the My FezCard Viewer app to see their newly designed digital membership car.
- How the temple will identify the status of their membership (dues) status, through the My FezCard Viewer and/or scanning of the QR Code on either the digital card or the gold-colored hard membership card.
- The discontinuation of the sticker mailers from Shriners International direct to members.

### How to Download and Use My FezCard Viewer

- 1. Open the App Store on your phone.
- 2. Search for "My FezCard Viewer" and click on the icon.
- 3. Click the "Install" button to install My FezCard Viewer.



# FEZ FOODIES

### FILIPINO CHICKEN ADOBO

#### INGREDIENTS

One of the most amazing Asian chicken thigh recipes I have ever come across. Intense in flavors, but so fast and easy to prepare! Chicken is so tender, it's like it's been slow cooked. Chicken and Marinade

- 750g / 1.5 lb chicken thigh fillets
- 3 garlic cloves
- 1/3 cup (85ml) soy sauce
- 1/3 cup + 2 tbsp white vinegar
- 4 bay leaves (fresh) or 3 dried
- For cooking
- 2 tbsp oil
- 3 garlic cloves
- 1 small onion
- 11/2 cups (375 ml) water
- 2 tbsp brown sugar
- 1 tbsp whole black pepper

#### Serving:

• 2 green onions/scallions

#### Instructions

- Combine Chicken and Marinade ingredients in a bowl. Marinate for at least 20 minutes, or up to overnight.
- Heat 1 tbsp oil in a skillet over high heat. Remove chicken from marinade (reserve marinade) and place in the pan. Sear both sides until browned about 1 minute on each side. Do not cook the chicken all the way through.
- Remove chicken skillet and set aside.
- Heat the remaining oil in skillet. Add garlic and onion, cook 1 1/2 minutes.
- Add the reserved marinade, water, sugar and black pepper. Bring it to a simmer then turn heat down to medium high. Simmer 5 minutes.
- Add chicken smooth side down. Simmer uncovered for 20 to 25 minutes (no need to stir), turning chicken at around 15 minutes, until the sauce reduces down to a thick jam-like syrup.
- If the sauce isn't thick enough, remove chicken onto a plate and let the sauce simmer by itselfit will thicken much quicker - then return chicken to the skillet to coat in the glaze.
- Coat chicken in glaze then serve over rice. Pictured in post as a healthy dinner plate (415calories) with cauliflower rice and Ginger Smashed Cucumbers.

- 1. Clean and fill Christmas ornaments with cranberry juice (and optionally a bit of fireball to taste)
- 2. put 3 ice cubes into each glass
- 3.top with champagne to cover the ice
- 4. Add one Christmas ornament to the top of each glass


