

# Tales from the Almas Crypt As told by Frank Ireton, Past Potentate

This month's tale is from the 1945
August-September issue of the Almas
Alibi. The cover, as seen in the scanned
image, is of General Douglas MacArthur.
No further story or description is
provided in this issue or reference to
MacArthur visiting Almas. The
Potentate's message starts with a
discussion of World War II ending and
also included in the issue is a listing of
Almas Nobles killed, missing in action,
and/or honored.


Douglas MacArthur (26 January 1880 – 5 April 1964) served as General of the United States Army as well as a field marshal to the Philippine Army. MacArthur was nominated for the Medal

of Honor three times and received it for his service in the Philippines campaign. He and his father, Arthur MacArthur, were the first father and son to be awarded the medal. He was one of only five men to rise to the rank of General of the U.S. Army since 1944. MacArthur died at Walter Reed Army Medical Center in 1964 and is buried in the rotunda of the Douglas MacArthur Memorial—the former Norfolk City Hall.

On January 17, 1936 over six hundred Master Masons watched as M.W. Samuel Hawthorne, Grand Master of Masons in the Philippines made General MacArthur a Mason at sight. The Entered Apprentice Degree was given by P.G.M. Frederick H. Steven. P.G.M. Francisco A. Delagado conferred the Fellowcraft Degree, and M.W. Samuel Hawthorne raised General MacArthur to the sublime degree of Master Mason. After being raised as a Master Mason MacArthur affiliated with Manila Lodge No.1 and on March 13th joined the Scottish Rite. On October 19, 1937, he was elected Knight Commander Court of Honor, and on December 8, 1947, he was coroneted Honorary 33rd Degree at the American Embassy in Tokyo. He became a life member of the Nile Shrine Temple in Seattle, Washington.

John Wayne visited Shriners Children's Hawaii in Honolulu in 1952, spending time with some of the patients.

#### An American Freemason - John Wayne

Duke was drawn to fraternal organizations throughout his life. Growing up, he was a member of the Glendale DeMolay chapter and belonged to the Trojan Knights and Sigma Chi fraternities at the University of Southern California. Later in life, he followed in the footsteps of his father and became a Freemason in 1970. He would come to relish the time he spent among his Brothers, remarking

that he felt at home in the lodge as if his fame melted away. John Wayne's <u>Masonic lodge</u> was Marion McDaniel Lodge No. 56 in Tucson, Arizona. Soon after earning his degrees, he became a member of the York Rite, joined Al Malaikah Shrine Temple in Los Angeles, as well as <u>32nd-degree Scottish Rite Freemasonry</u>

# FEZ FOODIES

#### FRESH ONINON DIP

#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 3-1/2 tablespoons olive oil, divided
- 1 Vidalia onion, thinly sliced
- 2 yellow onions, thinly sliced
- 2 shallots, thinly sliced
- 1 leek, white part only, cleaned and thinly sliced
- kosher or sea salt and freshly ground black pepper, to taste
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 1/4 cup balsamic vinegar
- 2 cups sour cream



#### **Instructions**

- In a skillet over medium-low heat, warm 2-1/2 tablespoons of oil. Add all onions. (If your skillet isn't large enough, divide onions and oil among two pans.) Cook, stirring every 5 minutes or so, until onions are wilted; then reduce heat to low and continue cooking until onions are very soft, turning a pale golden color, about 30 minutes more. Season with salt and pepper. Add garlic and vinegar and cook for 10 minutes, stirring occasionally. Remove from heat and let cool a bit. Taste for seasoning and add more salt or pepper as needed.
- Transfer mixture to a food processor and blend slightly. You don't want the onions to be pureed, but look for a chunky consistency. Add sour cream and remaining 1 tablespoon of oil, and blend again, pulsing a few times until incorporated. Taste for seasoning and add more salt or pepper as needed.

#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 1 can refried beans
- 1 pound ground beef, cooked with taco seasonings
- 1 medium jar salsa
- 3/4 pounds cheddar cheese, grated, plus more for topping
- 1 cup sour cream
- tomatoes, chopped (optional)
- peppers, chopped (optional)
- black olives, chopped (optional)
- tortilla chips



#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

• Layer refried beans, beef, salsa, and cheese in a 9"X13" pan. Bake at 350 for 20 minutes. Once cooled, spread with sour cream. Top with tomatoes, peppers, olives, or any ingredients you desire. Sprinkle cheddar cheese over finished dip. Serve with tortilla chips.

## Garlic Fried Rice with Shrimp and Scallops



## Ingredients

One egg
One tablespoon milk
Three tablespoons butter divided
One cup prepared rice
One tablespoon minced onion
One tablespoon garlic
Diced shrimp
Fourth cup chopped baby spinach
Salt, lemon pepper, Italian
seasoning and Old Bay
Optional
Diced scallops
Diced mushroom

Prepare rice and egg ahead of time For the scrambled egg. Melt Tbs butter in sauté pan, whisk in egg and milk. Set aside.

Melt tablespoon of butter in medium skillet. Add onions and garlic, toss until clear. Add remaining butter, stir in rice and toss to coat with butter. Add shrimp—scallops and mushrooms if including—spices to taste, and stir until the shrimp turn pink. Stir in egg and spinach, stir until spinach is wilted.

To serve pour mixture into a cereal bowl and invert a plate over the top. Flip back over, decorate with spinach leaves and garnish with parsley or spinach leaf. Sprinkle Old Bay.

#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 11/2 cups white grape juice
- 1 cup vodka
- 1 cup seedless grapes, halved
- 1 crisp red apple, quartered, cored and sliced 1/4-inch thick
- 1 orange, quartered and sliced
- Five 12-ounce bottles wheat beer, well chilled



#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Combine the grape juice, vodka, grapes, apples and oranges in a pitcher. Refrigerate at least 1 hour and up to 8 for the flavors to infuse.
- 2. Fill wine glasses halfway with the grape juice mixture and some fruit. Fill the rest of the glass with beer


